





Extra-strength glue stick Ruler/steel edge

Tweezers

Assembly Instructions

- 1. Using a scalpel or craft knife and ruler, carefully cut out each piece of the pattern.
- 2. Score each fold using the back of the blade or the handle of a spoon.
- 3. Crease each fold, as directed by the pattern.
 - a. Dotted and dashed lines indicate 'valley' folds. Valley folds fold 'out of' the pattern.
 - b. Dashed lines indicate 'ridge' folds. Ridge folds fold 'into' the pattern.
- 4. Apply a small dab of glue to each tab, and then fold the piece to achieve its correct form.
- 5. Use your tweezers to pinch each tab closed, and hold for a short while to allow the adhesive to dry.
- 6. Reapply glue as required during assembly.
- 7. Connect each piece together to complete the figurine.

Order of Assembly

Head, arms and legs

- 1. Assemble the head, legs and arms first.
- 2. Start assembly at the upper part of the limb and work your way down to the hands and feet.
- 3. Don't glue down the sole of the foot until you have assembled the rest of Tilo, and are ready to put him on his base stand.

Torso

- 1. Begin assembly of the torso at Tilo's waist, and work down.
- 2. Attach his legs to the body, before assembling Tilo's upper body.
- 3. Glue on Tilo's arms, and then lastly his head.

Base and accessories

- 1. Assemble his accessories (The lute, bell and lantern) and base.
- 2. Assemble the sides and top of the stand, leaving the base open
- 3. Fold and assemble the 'stand bracing', then insert into the stand.
